Lonnett Myer Jackson, Missing Person, Pittsburgh, and Unsolved Cases

When Lonnett Myer Jackson left her home in the 5100 block of Chaplain Way in Pittsburgh's Hazelwood neighborhood sometime after 11 a.m. on April 11, 2006, she left behind her cell phone, keys and money.

Relatives think she took her identification and Social Security cards, though. But she has not been seen or heard from since that day.

At the time of her disappearance, Lonnett was 46 years old, 192 pounds and between 5-foot-3 to 5-foot-6. She had graying black hair and brown eyes, a surgical scar on the right side of her head near the hairline, a scar from a Cesarean section and pierced ears.

She was dressed in a white undershirt, black sleeveless hooded jacket, dark blue warm-up pants and white athletic shoes. She was also known by her nicknames—Tootsie and Nett. She would be 53 years old now.

Lonnett's family was concerned because she suffered from a medical condition and required medication.
